In recognition of the valuable assistance to the communities that the AAA caters to through these services the Association has been granted exemption from Income Tax.

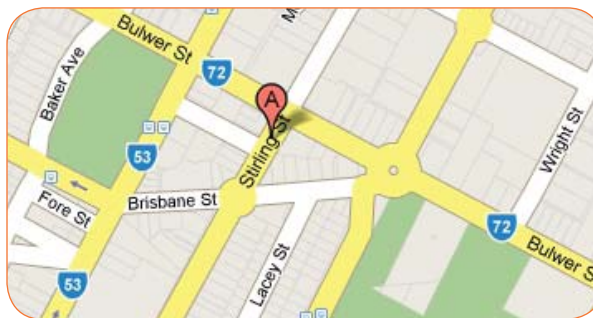

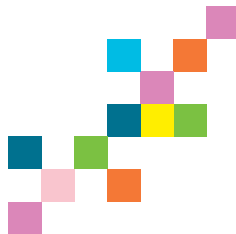
